The live auction will be held on December 4 at approximately 9:30pm. Live bidders in the room will be notified that there is a sealed envelope bid. At the end of bidding, if the sealed envelope bid wins, the bidder's credit card will be charged immediately and the bidder will be notified by SMS. If the transaction fails, the winning bidder will be contacted immediately by phone. If the bidder cannot be reached to obtain alternate credit card details, the next highest bid – whether by a bidder in the room or by sealed envelope bid – will become the winning bidder. If the winning bid is made by a bidder in the room, sealed envelope bidders will be notified by email on Monday December 7 that their bid was unsuccessful.

The winning bidder must coordinate and pay for all transport of their item, either from the Hordern Pavilion on December 4 or from the McGrath Foundation office in Northbridge the following week.
