McGrath Foundation High Tea Party Raffle Adelaide 2010

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms and conditions of entry.
2. To be eligible to enter, participants are required to attend one of the High Tea Party sittings at the Stamford Grand Moseley Square in Glenelg SA on 4th September 2010, and purchase a raffle ticket during their sitting.
3. Entrants must complete or receive assistance from a McGrath Foundation Raffle Ticket Seller in completing their contact details in the section provided.
4. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be ineligible. Complete entries will include a first and last name, a full address and/or a telephone number, at a minimum.
5. Entrants are not restricted or limited to the number of raffle tickets which may be purchased.
6. Raffle ticket sales will commence on 4th September 2010 at 9:00am and conclude at 5:59PM local time.
7. Entrants need not be present to win. Prizes cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash.
8. The draw for the winners will take place on 4th September 2010 at 6pm, at the Stamford Grand Moseley Square, Glenelg SA 5045. If the winners are under the age of 18 years the prizes will be awarded to their parents or legal guardians.
9. In the draw for the winners, the major prize will be drawn first and the other prizes drawn in descending order of the prize number and value.
10. The McGrath Foundation reserves the right to request winners to submit their ticket stub as proof of identity and purchase. Proof of identification and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the McGrath Foundation.
